RE: CENTRAL FILL PHARMACY LOCATIONS (Maintenance Rx)

IMPORTANT NOTICE

<u>Effective February 1, 2009</u>, the Central Fill Program will no longer be available at Times pharmacies. <u>There are fifteen (15) designated Longs Drugs Pharmacies on Oahu</u> that will be available for Central Fill Program services and will assist you in filling your long term (maintenance) prescriptions. *(Please see attached listing of the fifteen (15) designated Longs Drugs pharmacies).*

REMINDER:

The Central Fill Program is designed to provide up to a 60-day supply of long term (maintenance) prescription drugs to treat conditions such as diabetes, high blood pressure and high cholesterol.

HOW TO TRANSFER YOUR PRESCRIPTION TO LONGS DRUGS

If you have remaining refills on your prescription through a Times Pharmacy that you need to transfer to Longs Drugs, you will need to do the following:

- 1. Contact the designated Central Fill Longs Drugs Pharmacy location in your area and speak with a pharmacy representative.
- 2. Notify the pharmacy representative that you are a member of the AFL Health and Welfare Trust Fund and you need to transfer your prescription from a Times Pharmacy. (Be sure to have the Times Pharmacy location and the prescription number available)

3. The pharmacy representative will assist you with further instructions on completing your prescription transfer.

<u>The process of transferring a prescription may take up to 24 hours to</u> <u>complete</u>. If you prefer not to transfer the prescription, you may <u>contact your physician</u> to request a new prescription. Have your physician call or fax the prescription to Longs Drugs.

If you need to obtain your prescription on that business day, your physician must instruct Longs Drugs to have the prescription available for immediate pick up.

The locations and telephone numbers of the designated Longs Drugs Central Fill pharmacies is attached for your information. Please keep this listing for future reference.

<u>IMPORTANT NOTE</u>: The <u>Central Fill Program</u> services are <u>only available at these fifteen (15)</u> <u>designated Longs Drugs Pharmacy locations</u> on Oahu, and <u>not at any other Longs Drugs locations.</u>
