SUBJECT: Comprehensive Medical Plan and Vision Care Program

The Board of Trustees, at their meeting on October 29, 2009, adopted the following changes:

I. Comprehensive Medical Plan

In accordance with the Mental Health Parity and Addiction Equity Act of 2008, **<u>effective January 1, 2010</u>**, the following Comprehensive Medical Plan <u>Mental</u> <u>Illness and Alcohol or Drug Dependence benefit limitations will change as</u> <u>follows</u>:

- A. The maximum of 30 days per calendar year for hospital and facility services for mental illness and alcohol or drug dependence is removed. However, hospital and facility services for mental illness and alcohol or drug dependence shall count against the hospital inpatient services maximum of 365 days per calendar year for all covered services.
- B. The maximum of 30 inpatient visits per calendar year by a Psychiatrist, Psychologist, Clinical Social Worker, Licensed Mental Health Counselor or Marriage and Family Therapist for mental illness and alcohol or drug dependence is <u>removed</u>. However, an inpatient visit by a Psychiatrist, Psychologist, Clinical Social Worker, Licensed Mental Health Counselor or Marriage and Family Therapist for mental illness and alcohol or drug dependence or Marriage and Family Therapist for mental illness and alcohol or drug dependence shall count against the physician services maximum of one (1) visit per day for an inpatient admission.

- C. The maximum of 12 outpatient visits per calendar year by a Psychiatrist, Psychologist, Clinical Social Worker, Licensed Mental Health Counselor or Marriage and Family Therapist for mental illness and alcohol or drug dependence is <u>removed</u>, and there is no longer a limitation on outpatient visits per calendar year by a Psychiatrist, Psychologist, Clinical Social Worker, Licensed Mental Health Counselor or Marriage and Family Therapist for mental illness and alcohol or drug dependence.
- D. Each inpatient psychological testing session for mental illness and alcohol or drug dependence shall no longer count against the 30 inpatient visits per calendar year maximum, but shall count against the physician services maximum of one (1) visit per day for an inpatient admission.
- E. Each outpatient psychological testing session for mental illness and alcohol or drug dependence shall no longer count against the 21 outpatient visits per calendar year maximum, and there is no longer a limitation on the number of outpatient psychological testing sessions per calendar year.
- F. The maximum of 2 treatment episodes per lifetime for alcohol or drug dependence treatment is <u>removed</u>, and there is no longer a limitation on the number of treatment episodes per lifetime.

In addition, <u>effective January 1, 2010</u>, the Comprehensive Medical Plan <u>no</u> <u>longer requires prior authorization for non-inpatient Mental Health/Substance</u> <u>Abuse Services</u>. However, the Plan still requires prior authorization for all inpatient admissions, including those for Mental Health/Substance Abuse Services. Failure to obtain prior authorization may result in a reduction of benefits. The above revises the sections entitled, "Authorizations and Requirements" and "Mental Illness and Alcohol or Drug Dependence Services" of the Summary Plan Description (Hotel Bargaining Unit) dated March 2006 and of the Summary Plan Description (Kaiser Bargaining Unit) dated December 2005.

II. Vision Care Program

A. <u>New Providers</u>

Effective December 1, 2009, the following vision care providers will be added as a participating provider under the vision care program. The name, address, telephone number, and type of services available for each provider are as follows:
