Medical Plans

Two (2) choices are available – **AFL Self-Funded Comprehensive Medical Plan** and the **Kaiser Permanente Plan**. The AFL Comprehensive Medical Plan is a preferred provider or "freedom of choice" plan. You may receive services from the doctor of your choice and payments are based on a percentage of Eligible Charges. Under this plan, your out-of-pocket costs are usually lower when you receive services from a participating provider. The Kaiser Permanente Plan is an "HMO Plan." You must receive services from a Kaiser Permanente doctor, and your co-payment is usually a fixed dollar amount. The plan will not pay for services from a non-Kaiser Permanente doctor, except when referred or if emergency care is required. Kaiser Permanente facilities include: Oahu, Big Island and Maui.
