SUBJECT: **INDEMNITY PRESCRIPTION DRUG PLAN CHANGES**

The following are important changes to the Indemnity Prescription Drug Plan.

PLEASE BE SURE TO READ THIS INFORMATION CAREFULLY.

By using the programs as described below, you may limit your out-of-pocket costs for prescription drugs.

Effective February 1, 2009, the Indemnity Prescription Drug plan benefits will change as follows:

- **For Long Term (Maintenance) Prescriptions** (medications for chronic conditions such as diabetes, high cholesterol, high blood pressure; those taken for more than 15 days), you may obtain your prescriptions through the Central Fill Program which is available at designated Longs Drugs pharmacies on the Big Island of Hawaii, Maui and Kauai. *(Please refer to attached listing of designated Longs Drugs pharmacies on your Island)*
- **For Short Term (Acute) Prescriptions** (drugs such as antibiotics or those taken for up to 15 days), you may obtain your prescriptions through any Catalyst Rx participating pharmacy under the Point-of-Service (POS) Program. *(Please refer to the attached listing of participating Point of Service pharmacies on your Island)*

****LONG TERM PRESCRIPTIONS****

Central Fill Program

The Central Fill Program has been designed to provide up to a 60-day supply of your long term (maintenance) prescriptions. Under the Central Fill Program, you may fill your prescriptions at any designated Longs Drugs pharmacy on your island by following the steps below:

- Step 1: Obtain a prescription from your doctor.
- Step 2: Go to a designated Longs Drugs pharmacy and present your HMA/Catalyst Rx identification card.
- Step 3: If this is the **first time** that you are taking this drug or dosage of the drug, the pharmacy will fill your prescription for an initial (first time) fill of 15 days at the following copayments:

15-Day Supply (Initial Fill)

Generic Drugs, Insulin & Supplies	\$ 6.00
Brand Name Drugs	\$18.00

If your doctor continues your prescription for this drug and dosage, you may obtain a Refill for a 60-day supply.

- Step 4: Call the Longs Drugs pharmacy at least three (3) days before your prescription supply runs out and request a refill at the following copayments:

60-Day Supply (Refill)

Generic Drugs, Insulin & Supplies	\$ 9.00
Brand Name Drugs	\$28.00

Central Fill Program services are only available at the designated Longs Drugs pharmacies on the attached listing for the Big Island of Hawaii, Maui and Kauai and not at any other Longs Drugs store locations.

****SHORT-TERM PRESCRIPTIONS****

Point of Service (POS) Program

Under the Point of Service (POS) Program, you may obtain your short-term prescriptions for up to a 15-day supply from any Catalyst Rx participating POS pharmacy on your island at the following copayments:

	<u>15-Day Supply Limit</u>
Generic Drugs, Insulin & Supplies	\$ 6.00
Brand Name Drugs	\$18.00

Prescriptions will no longer be available for a 21-day supply under the POS program, however, for prepackaged prescription drugs that can only be dispensed in “unbreakable” packages (e.g. creams, ointments, certain inhalers), the days supply limit shall be equivalent to the package size days supply, not to exceed a 30 days supply, at the applicable 15-day supply copayment.

For prescriptions requiring more than a 15-day supply, please use the Central Fill Program described above.

Direct Reimbursement and Mail Order Programs

There is no change to the Direct Reimbursement Program or the Mail Order Program through Walgreen’s. Please refer to your Summary Plan Description on pages 62 - 64 (Hotel Bargaining Unit) and pages 75 and 77 (Kaiser Bargaining Unit) for detailed coverage information on these prescription drug programs.
